




1886年，來自俄勒岡州波特蘭市的湯傑卿牧師前來協助夏維爾博士。1888年，該事工遷入現址。夏維爾博士返回中國，而湯傑卿牧師繼續牧會14年。



全國各地教會的捐款僅夠建造兩層樓，並附帶一個屋頂聚會場所。隨著會友人數的增加和對更多空間的需求，浸信會本土宣教協會(Baptist Home Mission Society)購買了沙加緬度街(Sacramento Street)隔壁的一塊地。新建工程預計耗資1萬至2萬美元，但由於美國經濟不景氣，該項目被擱置。這裡就是如今的黃顯護遊樂場(Willie “Woo Woo” Wong Playground)的所在地。







## A Live Church in Action

The First Chinese Baptist Church of San Francisco occupies a unique place in the history of Chinatown and all Chinese work in the state of California. Its history goes back into the early days of the city's life, but the program of the church is today more virile and efficient than at any time in its history. About 8 years ago the Bay Cities Baptist Union cooperated with the Church in an extensive reconstruction program of the building, adding a third floor with a magnificent social hall. The church building, as it stands today is one of the best equipped anywhere to be found. It is located on Sacramento Street at Waverly Place in the heart of Chinatown in what is a most strategic corner. On the two back sides of the Church the City of San Francisco has one of its finest playgrounds, but the program of the church is today more equipped with courts for basketball and tennis and with playground equipment for the little children, all carefully supervised by the City and always available for our Chinese boys and girls of the School.

It is probable that this Church has one of the most intensive programs of any church in the entire country. Rev. Albert C. Lau has been Pastor of the Church for four years. The Sunday School has an enrollment of upwards 300. The chief worship service of the week is at the noon hour on Sunday. In addition to the many and varied activities normally related to the life of a church there are two other distinctive features.

One is the Week Day Language School in which the American Baptist Women's Home Mission Society cooperates in furnishing four efficient teachers under the principalship of Miss Elsie Anderson, Miss Ruby Umstead, Miss Celia Allen and Miss Marguerite Calder. Miss Anderson is to be released by the Society for a year of study, beginning with the next School year. She will be succeeded by Miss Calder as Principal which position she held for a number of years preceding her term of missionary service in China which terminates.

**HISTORICAL DATA**

The First Chinese Baptist Church was organized by Dr. J. B. Hartwell at a rented house on Washington Street in October, 1880 with 9 members.

The first pastor, Rev. Tong Kit Hing, who came from Portland, took up the work in 1886.

The first church building was erected in the present location in 1888.

The building was completely destroyed by the earthquake and fire on April 18, 1906.

The present building was erected and dedicated in 1908.

An extensive remodeling program was undertaken in 1930, when another story was added.

Besides Rev. Tong Kit Hing, the Chinese pastors have been Rev. Lee Tzai Leung, Rev. Liu Chek On, Rev. Huan Leung Tsay, Rev. Chan Luke Shan, Rev. Chau Pik Kum, Rev. Moy Kwok Fong and the present pastor, Rev. Albert Lau.






「伸展主的產業」運動於 1998 年秋季發起，旨在籌集 130 萬美元，用於市政府強制要求的整座建築防地震改造。工程於 1999 年夏天開始，會眾在附近的劉貴明小學校內崇拜一年多。翻修完成後，於 2000 年舉行了重新獻殿儀式。
